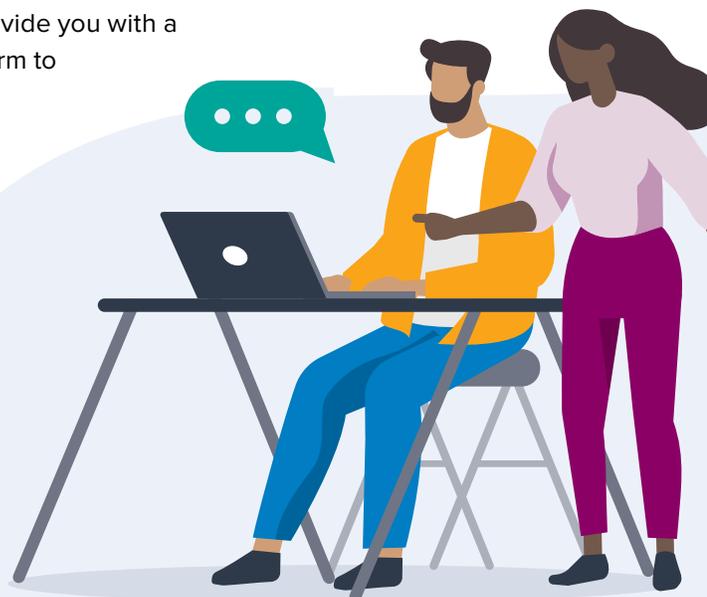

We have two models in our program:

Our Adult Continuing Education Model is geared for the working adult looking to develop their professional skill set and marketability by completing our self-paced, on-demand, hands-on 16-hour security analyst course. We provide the course materials and access to our virtual lab environment to you for inclusion in your adult continuing education offerings.

Our Academic Model is designed to help you incorporate the use of a real-world tool into your undergraduate and graduate curriculums. We provide you with a Not-For-Resale license of the LogRhythm NextGen SIEM Platform to use as a sandbox, free administrator and analyst training for instructors, access to all our training materials, and support in customizing our lab exercises to suit your specific program needs.

Virtual Machines used for hands-on labs and exercises are provided by a third-party vendor/partner (InfoSec Learning) at very low cost to students with an option to be paid for directly by the students via credit card. These are considered lab fees and priced accordingly.
